## Masonic Hall Centenary.

May 1923 was indeed an important month in the planning and final decision to proceed with the building of the New Masonic Hall. Financially, the Members of the Lodge had worked very hard fund raising and the Balance Sheet of 26th. October 1922 shows that the balance in the Building Fund stood at £2,900/14/11d The Lodge was also active in other areas,

on the 9th. May it was proposed that the Lodge should have a summer recess and a motion was put that "The Lodge St. Bryde close from the 1st. Meeting in June until the end of August" This Motion would be unanimously adopted at a future meeting of the Lodge.

Previously, the Lodge had written to Grand Secretary regarding the upcoming review of the Grand Lodge Constitution and Laws. Our Lodge had objected that the Senior and Junior Wardens of Lodges would be unable to confer the Obligation under the new changes. Bro. J. Hotchkiss our WJW attended the meeting and reported to our Members on 23rd. May that Grand Lodge had decided to include the Wardens in the new Law 170 which would allow them to confer the Obligations in their own Lodges. The Building Committee reported that several amendments had been made to the original plans for the New Hall and that the Committee had great pleasure in submitting the amended plans to the Lodge with a fixed cost of £3,060, excluding painting and furnishings.

The Brethren unanimously agreed that the Lodge proceed with the building of the New Masonic Hall in Uddingston. The Brethren thanked the Committee for their hard work and looked forward to the day when the Lodge met in the new premises.
