

# Masonic Hall Centenary. *October 1922.*

In October 1922 the Lodge Minutes appear to show that despite a previous vote in favour of the Gardenside St., site the Members were still not happy. It was again proposed that a vote be taken on which site to purchase, Gardenside or Bellshill Rd., The outcome was decisive, 5 votes for Bellshill Road. 22 for

Gardenside St.. However a second proposal that the whole matter be referred to the Halls Committee and they be given powers to secure a site, was again put to the vote and the outcome was 22 votes for and 22 votes against! The Right Worshipful Master, Bro. William Andrew had the casting vote and he declared that the previous decision to secure the Gardenside St. site be adopted and that the Halls Committee work to this end. The Lodge also received correspondence from Provincial Grand Lodge asking the Lodge to confirm their support for extending the Commission of Sir Robert King Stewart as Provincial Grand Master or propose another candidate. The Lodge voted in favour of Sir Robert King Stewart continuing his Commission.
