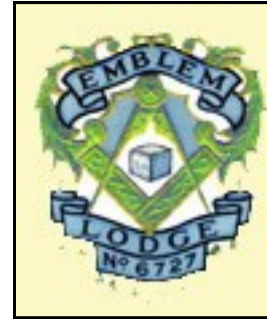

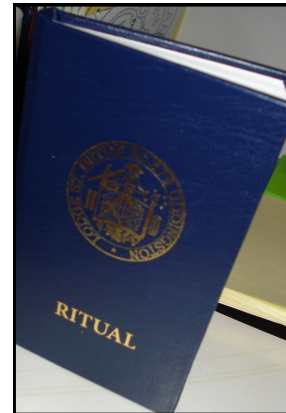

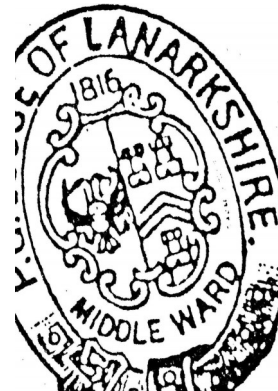
Emblem Lodge No. 6727, Blackpool.

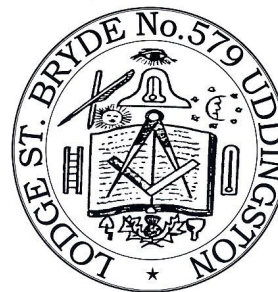
Important Information Wanted.

arranging for two scaffolding towers to be delivered and erected and we are grateful for their use. The annual garden clean up took place under the

direction of Andrew McAlpine, this years task included

cutting back the fast growing brambles (not an easy job). The pillar on the North Wall which the War Memorial will be positioned was investigated by Duncan Mulholland and found to be suitable to take the Memorial which has now been delivered. A



survey of the outer walls of the building was carried out by specialist contractors and it has been recommended that extensive re-pointing work is required in the near future. The East and North walls were completed during the recess.
