

4th. International Scottish Masonic Conference. Edinburgh 20th.-23rd. November 2022. "The Vision for 2030 and beyond" is the theme of this years Conference.

The Conference will take place in Freemasons Hall and will conclude with the Installation and Festival of St. Andrew on Thursday 24th.

November and a Special Supreme Royal Arch Meeting in Freemasons Hall on Friday 25th. November. The cost of attending the Conference (excluding the Festival of St. Andrew) is £200 for Standard Registration (1st. May to 10th. October) and £120 for a Day Pass Registration (The Conference will be limited to 300 attendees.) The main function of Proxy Members is to represent our Lodges overseas in Grand Lodge. In recent years better communications have been established between overseas Lodges and our Proxy Members here in Scotland and recently a number of Proxy vacancies have become available. The Annual Proxy Membership Fee is £30 per year and this enables Members to attend and vote in Grand Lodge. 12.00 pm on Thursday, 24th. November 2022. Thereafter,
the Festival of St Andrew will be celebrated at 3.30pm also
at the same venue. Tickets are £75 each.



Masonic Hall Centenary. September 1922.

Two Regular Meetings were held during this month. Earlier an agreement had been reached in principal to build a Masonic Hall on Mr. Latta's Garden site (in what is now Gardenside Street). James Patrick, P.M. raised a Notice of Motion that the proposal be "Cancelled and Withdrawn" and that negotiations be

opened with the agents of the building site on the Bellshill Road (opposite the Baptist Church). The Notice was seconded and would be discussed at the next Regular Meeting. At the next Regular Meeting The Notice of Motion was discussed at length. The main reasons for the Notice were a bad entrance to the building down a side street, a main sewer running through the property and the cost of levelling up the land. The WSW moved that the Lodge proceed with Mr. Latta's proposal, this was seconded and it was accepted by the Brethren although an investigation would be carried out regarding the "alleged sewer". If all went well the purchase would be made by November 1922.
