Alston Roofing has

started work on repairing the apex coverings on our Hall roof. After an inspection by the company it was recommended that new coverings be installed. This means that water ingress between the flagstones is eliminated and the procedure comes with a twenty five year guarantee. Ongoing inspection and repairs to the roof are essential and gutters and downpipes must be cleaned on an annual basis.
